

Seer Agreement

1. Definitions

The following terms will be used throughout this document. Their meanings are defined as below, unless otherwise stated.

- Webmaster: Person responsible for hosting and maintenance of this site.
- Seer: Person who is giving a reading of any type on the site.
- Client: Person who purchases a reading of any type on this site.

1. General Agreements

You agree to abide by all terms and conditions found in the General Terms and Conditions.

2. How Payment Works

Payments made on this website are made through PayPal. All terms, conditions, policies, agreements, etc. of PayPal are hereby incorporated into this agreement. By agreeing to these terms, you also agree to abide by all PayPal stipulations, and to not hold the Webmaster liable for any disputes with PayPal.

When you register as a Seer with this site, you will have an option to either receive a check by mail or via PayPal where your payments will be deposited. The Webmaster is entitled to 25% of all sales through this web service. From time to time there may be payment promotions (sales, coupons, etc) chosen by the Webmaster. In this case, the reduction in price will be split evenly between the Seer and the Webmaster. For example if you give a coupon or sale for 10% off a reading, your payment will be reduced by 5% of the regular price, and the Webmaster's will be reduced by 5%. If you choose to create a payment promotion, the Webmaster will not split the cost, and will still be entitled to 25% of the total pre-discount price of the reading.

If you terminate the reading session early you will not be paid. This includes personal computer failure, personal internet connection failure, and server failure. The only exclusion is if you encounter an obnoxious user.

Payment for a reading will not be available until PayPal has released the funds to the Webmaster, according to their terms and policies. The Webmaster has a right to hold payments in the event of disputed charges, or any other situations that would require a Client refund. To get paid, a Seer must request payments from the Webmaster.

3. Client Refunds

You agree to abide by PayPal User Agreement. If a Client issues reversal via PayPal, you will not receive payment, regardless of whether a full reading was issued to the Client, or whether you've already received payment. In the case that you have already received payment, a deduction will be made to your account. If you would like to dispute the reversal, you must go through the PayPal Online Resolution Center, as per the PayPal User Agreement. The Webmaster will not be held liable for timing of payments, disputes, or refunds on payments.

4. Taxes

Seer is responsible for all taxes due on earnings. Webmaster may send Form 1099 at the end of the year. You may be required to submit you EIN or Social Security Number for tax purposes.
